“AWAKE THE WHITE AND WINT’RY QUEEN” A TRIAD ORIGINAL

December 23rd will mark the return of “Awake The White And Wint’ry Queen”, a seasonal, winter-solstice concert unique to the Triad, written, composed and produced by Scott Fray. In 2011, the show enters its fourth year of production, playing one performance only at the Carolina Theatre in downtown Greensboro at 8:00pm. Audiences are invited to purchase tickets via the Carolina Theatre Box Office. Children (under 12) are FREE!

A concert to celebrate the return to the season of light, “Awake The White And Wint’ry Queen”, blends original music and world-beat grooves with dance performances and a sense of spectacle. The show features the soaring voices and instruments of some of the Triad’s most eclectic musical talent, accentuated by dance, projected video elements and spoken word. New to the production this year are the vocal talents of Crystal Bright of “Crystal Bright and the Silver Hands”, Karon Click of “Karon Click and the Hot Licks”, and Audrey Fannin of “OverReaction Jackson”. Also new this year are folk tales showcasing the acting talents of local children, written and directed by award-winning playwright Karen Dresser. Returning talent Bradford Reaves and Renee Henry of “One String Over” and Amber Marlowe of “Windfall” reprise their roles as well as adding new arrangements and new material.

The show’s creator, Scott Fray, made international headlines earlier this year, winning The 2011 World Bodypainting Festival in Portschach, Austria, with partner, Madelyn Greco (who appears as the Winter Queen). The pair comprise Living Brush Bodypainting based in Reidsville, NC, and are also the current North American Bodypainting Champions, a title awarded to them this spring in Dallas, TX; as well as the holders of the current Guinness World Record for bodypainting.

A sparkling, contemporary alternative to the standard holiday fare, “Awake the White and Wint’ry Queen” hopes to rekindle the magic that surrounds the turning of the seasons.
